**LORD NELSON “TRAFALGAR” PALEALE
4.4% ABV**

Biscuity malt on the palate with a long dry finish.
English malts and hops. A great session ale.



**LORD NELSON BREWERY “3 SHEETS” PALE
ALE 4.9% ABV**

Lord Nelson is Australia’s oldest pub brewery so these guys understand the meaning of beer. They brew with only malt, hops, yeast and water with no added sugars, preservatives or additives - ensuring a 100% natural beer.

Their pale ale has overtones of herbaceous hops and citrus florals with a malty dry finish culminating in a thoroughly refreshing beverage.



**LORD NELSON “QUAYLE” SUMMER ALE
4.4% ABV**

Refreshing easy drinking ale with subtle malt flavours and citrus aromas. Hallertau hops lighter malts. Nice introduction with high drinkability.



MONTEITH'S

Stewart Monteith was a master brewer and troublemaker who was jailed for running an illegal brewery on the West Coast of New Zealand. In 1868 he set about brewing a beer for gold mining men (not the type you want to disappoint). Luckily Stewart didn't disappoint and was defined by the phrase, "It's not about what you've done; it's what you do next that counts."

After nearly 150 years brewing experience, Monteith's Brewing Company is recognised as one of the leaders in the Australasian craft beer market, with a continuously evolving range in which both beer and cider lovers discover something to savour.

The Brewery is located in Greymouth in the remote west coast region of the South Island of New Zealand.

MONTEITH'S ORIGINAL ALE 4% ABV

This ale delivers a full, round and complete beer flavour. It's the hops that dominate the aroma and taste. However, on closer inspection, there's a subtle blackberry aroma which originates from the female flowers of the Pacific gem hops.



MONTEITH'S PACIFIC PALE ALE 4.6% ABV

This ale combines the intensity of North West American hops with the liveliness of New Zealand hops and is filtered to give it a clear straw appearance. Beginning with a zesty citrus aroma, this pale ale has a full malt flavour and crisp finish. Perfect for evoking a warm summery feeling.



MONTEITH'S RED CELTIC ALE 5% ABV

Due to its burnt red colour, typical of beers brewed on the Emerald Isle, Monteith's Celtic is considered an 'Irish style ale' but this beer is Kiwi through and through. It possesses a plethora of hidden flavours ranging from smoky kiln roast to a smooth chocolate malt.

CAVALIER PALE 5% ABV

Cavalier is an award winning microbrewery based in Melbourne that started brewing in March 2011. This beer is a modern twist on the classic Pale Ale.

Bucket loads of Nelson Sauvignon hops are added late in the boil to create its signature flavour. Bold grapefruit and passionfruit are supported by a firm but not overwhelming malt backbone.



FAT YAK PALE ALE 4.7% ABV

Fat Yak first impresses with its golden colour, distinctive, hop driven, fruity and herbaceous aromas, giving characteristic passionfruit and melon notes, followed by a hit of hop flavour at the finish. The taste is refreshingly clean on the palate.



BADLANDS PALE ALE 4.6% ABV

An ale inspired by the traditional summer ales from the heart of the English countryside. This pale ale combines the finest quality English Maris

Otter malted barley with premium Joe White Australian malt and gets its distinctive aroma from a healthy measure of English Goldings hops. The fresh, soft palette and unique fruity hint ends with a snappy bitterness that calls for another.

GRIFTER “EDWARD” PALE ALE 5% ABV

A pale ale with an explosive hop bitterness and aroma thanks to the use of all Australian grown hops - Topaz & Galaxy. It's golden haze appearance is due to being completely unfiltered leaving you with an ale of wholesome character. A clean American yeast strain and a subtle yet sturdy malt backing gives this beer the depth it needs to balance a healthy dose of hops.



VALE ALE 4.5% ABV

The foundation beer from the McLaren Vale Beer Company. This is a sophisticated and sessionable Australian pale ale with a refreshing balance of malt, hops and yeast characters. Hop additions of Amarillo and Cascade give a wonderfully fresh, crisp finish with lingering flavours of citrus. These flavours are matched beautifully with the sweet honey finish from the crystal malt.



ENDEAVOUR GROWERS BRIGHT ALE

4.2% ABV

The Growers Ale by the expert crew at Endeavour Brewing is a hand-crafted brew that is made in tribute to the artisan hop and barley growers in Australia who provide their quality produce to help create craft beers just like this. Exciting aromatic characters of fresh hops are clearly evident on a nose that gives way to an extremely refreshing palate with a superb long lasting finish.

MAD ABBOT TRIPEL 9.5% ABV

Golden ale with good clarity and a slight haziness from re-fermentation yeast in the bottle. Very effervescent with a thick creamy white head.

Complex fruity esters, white stone and tropical fruit, and malty flavours mix with sweet malt and citrus like characters with a bitterness and alcohol kick to balance in the lengthy finish.



WICKED ELF PALE ALE 5.4% ABV

This is The Little Brewing Company's version of an American pale ale using imported American ale yeast, American hops and English and Australian malts. Overall, this is a hoppy and flavoursome ale, rich copper in colour with good clarity and citrus aromas. The Oregon grown Cascade hops are finely balanced with the use of Crystal malts. Good with full flavoured game meats, curries and hotly spiced foods

BRIDGEPORT “KINGPIN” DOUBLE RED ALE
7.5% ABV

BridgePort Brewing Company is an American brewery located in Portland, Oregon. The brewery claims in their trademark to be “Oregon’s Oldest Craft Brewery”. This full-flavoured red ale is made with local, rarely-grown Liberty Hops.

Kingpin’s rye and caramel malts combine to create a unique flavour profile that’s triple-hopped at the kettle, hop jack, and cold conditioning tank for a bitter aroma and a special dry-hopped character.

The extraordinary component of this ale is that the taster can actually perceive the unique flavour signature of malted rye. It comes through as do the dry hopped Liberty hops and rich red colour. Only a handful of examples of Imperial Red or Double Red exist, so this is an emerging style.



MOO BREW PALE 4.9% ABV

Traditional pale ale styles are fused together to give a pungent floral and citrus aroma with a complex malt palate and pleasant late bitterness.

COOPERS 'RED' SPARKLING ALE 5.8% ABV

The ale by which all others should be measured. With its famous cloudy sediment and distinctive balance of malts, hops and fruity characters, this is a taste of the rich Coopers history.



**COOPERS EXTRA STRONG VINTAGE ALE
7.5% ABV**

Produced from the very best ingredients available each year, Coopers Extra Strong Vintage Ale is one of Australia's truly remarkable beers. The proven recipe of multiple hopping at different stages of brewing gives the beer a unique hop aroma and flavour courtesy of the German Perle and Magnum hops, Nelson Sauvignon hops from New Zealand and Centennial and Cascade hops from the United States. Coopers' well known bottle conditioning method also allows for cellaring of this amazing brew to further enhance its complexities and deliver a softer, sweeter palate of toffee and port wine.

Coopers

The Coopers Beer story began in 1862 in a newly established colony with a brilliant accident. After turning his hand to a number of trades, Thomas

Cooper discovered his talent as a brewer by accident; when he created his first batch of beer as a tonic for his ailing wife Ann.

Cooper saw the opportunity to create a beer that was free from the ‘peculiar flavour’ of colonial ales – he would introduce an all-natural beer from the very best ingredients. Locals quickly caught on and came to appreciate his brew for more than its medicinal attributes. As demand for his Sparkling Ale and Best Extra Stout grew, Thomas established a brewery at Leabrook, South Australia, in 1881.

COOPERS ‘GREEN’ PALE ALE 4.5% ABV

With fruity and floral characters, balanced with a crisp bitterness, Coopers Pale Ale has a compelling flavour which is perfect for every occasion. Naturally fermented in the ‘Burton-upon-Trent’ style, a secondary fermentation creates the trademark sediment that gives ‘pale’ its fine cloudy appearance.

JAMES SQUIRES “NINE TAILS” AMBER ALE
5% ABV

James Squire Original Amber Ale is a handcrafted blend of Pale and Crystal malts, three distinct hops and 140-year-old top fermenting ale yeast. Deep copper in colour with a creamy head, this beer rewards the appreciative drinker with a long, slightly nutty finish.



JAMES SQUIRES “THE CHANCER” GOLDEN ALE
4.5% ABV

James Squire Golden Ale’s rich orange-amber colour comes from toasted grains of wheat and barley, while new season Amarillo hops create a tropical fruit aroma with restrained bitterness. Mild carbonation and a dry finish make this an ideal thirst-slaking beer.



JAMES SQUIRES “ONE FIFTY LASHES” PALE ALE
4.7% ABV

Brewed using Nelson Sauvin and Amarillo hops this sessionable pale is sure to please. One Fifty Lashes is a refreshing Australian-style cloudy pale ale with restrained bitterness and a clean, smooth finish. The use of malted wheat also adds to its refreshing character delivering a beer with a fruity nose and hints of passionfruit, grapefruit and citrus.

MOUNTAIN GOAT STEAM ALE 4.5% ABV

The Steam is a crisp, certified organic ale. They incorporate a slap of wheat malt in the grist make-up and ferment it cool. This beer uses Cascade and Citra hops to give it a fresh, zippy finish. Great as the weather warms up.



MOUNTAIN GOAT HIGHTAIL ALE 4.5% ABV

The Hightail is an English inspired amber ale. It has a rich malt body and floral hop aroma. Mountain Goat handcraft their ales with the utmost care and avoid all preservatives, additives and pasteurisation.



4 Pines was established in 2008 as a small brewery/pub/bar/restaurant in Manly on Sydney's northern beaches. Before long, they outgrew the 500L 'pub brewery' leading to the opening of their 5000L brewery, kegging, and bottling facility in 2012.

Brewed to traditional purity laws, allowing only 4 ingredients; hops, water, yeast and malt (and the odd bit of mandarin, ginger and other natural stuff), 4 Pines brewing offers great flavour sensations through variety, quality craftsmanship, natural ingredients and traditional, time honoured techniques.



4 PINES PALE ALE 5.1% ABV

An American pale ale packed with four varieties of American hops and a full-bodied malt background. Aromas of pine and grapefruit come from the hops before the malt comes through with a tight and bitter finish



4 PINES KOLSCH 4.6% ABV

A bright ale that is light straw in colour. Aromas of lemon/lime prelude a light malty palate, finishing crisp and clean showing hints of spice and citrus.

YOUNG HENRY'S REAL ALE 4% ABV

This ale is a modern take on a classic English style Best Bitter featuring Topaz, Galaxy and Stella, new varietal hops from Australia. Solid malt backing with a long bitter finish



YOUNG HENRY'S HOP ALE 5% ABV

This beer harks back to the classic English style IPAs. Hefty malt backing meets truck loads of hop flowers added to all stages of the process. The all Australian hop flavour is not aggressive in its bitterness, but is evident in flavour and aroma and slowly asserts itself with a lengthy, lingering and thoroughly enjoyable palette



Like most great adventures, Young Henry's started with a conversation over a beer. In this case it was lovers of great beer getting together to discuss hopes and dreams for the Australian craft beer industry, particularly its growth and development in Sydney. For too long, Sydney had been seen to be lagging the rest of the country in terms of new, innovative and exciting breweries. Young Henry's was born out of a want to be just that: Innovative, passionate, adventurous and fun.

Young Henry's is situated in the heart of thriving Newtown surrounded by street art, creative industries and alternative culture. The state of the art, natural gas driven DME brewery produces ales, lagers and ciders of extraordinary quality. Along with the best quality ingredients sourced from Australia and around the world, the true source of flavour is experience, passion and the daring to do something a little different.



Little Creatures Brewing was born out of the love of great beer shared by a few good mates. Arguably the trailblazer of craft beer in Australia, Creatures began its journey in 2001 with their much loved Pale Ale. Their beer family has grown in Fremantle to encompass a Bright Ale, Roger's mid-strength and a Pilsner along with their ever growing list of single batch beers. They crowned their success with the opening of a dining hall in Melbourne's food and culture epicentre of Brunswick St and have been delivering fresh hop hits and fabulous eats ever since.

LITTLE CREATURES BRIGHT ALE 5% ABV

Crisp, clean and fresh, Bright Ale is a happy little beer that glows with sparkling golden Vienna and Cara malts and their own, local pale malt. To these they infuse the heady summer fruit aromas derived from a generous addition of hops in the brew house, leaving a refreshing balanced flavour and aroma.



LITTLE CREATURES PALE ALE 5.2% ABV

In the style of a hoppy American ale which has long dominated the pale ale market. It contains a truckload of Chinook and Cascade hop flowers sourced from the US along with some Tasmania which creates an intoxicating citrus and grapefruit aroma balanced with soft malts.



ROGERS 3.8% ABV

This mid-strength from Little Creatures has become a yardstick for all low alcohol beers. Nicely balanced flavours from whole hop flowers exist alongside toasted malts which give this beer toffee and caramel flavours culminating in an easy drinking session beer.

RIVERSIDE “FIFTY FIVE” PALE ALE
5.5% ABV

Fifty Five Pale Ale displays a deep amber colour along with an alluring full-bodied, complex character. They add truck loads of American cascade hops late in the brewing process giving the Fifty Five its classic bouquet and spicy flavour.



RIVERSIDE “THIRTY THREE” GOLDEN ALE
4.8% ABV

A beautiful deep golden colour, this Golden Ale is a fusion of American and English pale ale styles. Crisp and hoppy, it is bursting with citrus flavours and aromas.



RIVERSIDE “FORTY FOUR” AMBER ALE
6.5% ABV

When Riverside brewery first knocked the cap off its beer for public consumption, the ‘44’ Amber Ale was arguably the beer that won drinkers over with a single sip. It has a more-than-generous hit of American Cascade and Centennial hops which are exquisitely balanced on a big, roasty malt backbone. The deep brown colour, the bigness, the boldness; serve this up to a room full of beer lovers and there’ll be smiles all round.



Riverside Brewing Company is a craft brewery based in Western Sydney, Australia. At Riverside

Brewing they are dedicated to brewing pure, natural, hand-crafted beers that are bursting with flavour and aroma whilst being free of additives and preservatives.

Put simply, they brew beer that that locals, craft beer drinkers and they themselves would find a pleasure to drink.

All of Riverside's beers are brewed on-site in their brewhouse in Parramatta and are bottle conditioned and unfiltered to ensure the freshest beer possible.



IPAs.

SQUIRES “STOW AWAY” 5.5% ABV

Full of character, this beer stands its ground with robust malty flavours and earthy floral aromas from dry hopping with English Fuggles. Rich and golden in colour, it boasts a feisty bitterness with a lingering crisp finish.



VALE IPA 5.5% ABV

An Australian interpretation of an American IPA using a combination of hops from three countries: Galaxy from Australia, Nelson Sauvin from NZ and Citra from USA. Malt flavours are derived from the combination of pale, wheat and crystal hops. Very hop forward showing strong pine and citrus notes, with stone fruit and passionfruit characters



BADLANDS 5.2% ABV

This beer is for the hoplovers. Cascade and Sauvin hops give a powerful spicy, citrus hit. The solid malt backbone and assertive bitterness bring the beer into balance. Be careful... dangerously drinkable.

MOUNTAIN GOAT 6.2% ABV

First released only as one of their ‘rare breeds’ this IPA has become a firm favourite and all year brew. A bold US inspired take on the classic style, the hop characters and malty backbone come from a good dose of Citra and Galaxy hops that loiter on the palate with a strong bitterness. For the IPA aficionado.



MONTEITH'S IPA 5.5% ABV

There's plenty of rich maltiness from this Pale Ale and higher-kilned malt combination. The Cascade and special New Zealand hops create a fruity aroma with a dose of bitterness to drive home the hop flavour. A beer for the IPA aficionado with a distinctly Kiwi style.



LITTLE CREATURES “SHEPHERDS DELIGHT” 6.2% ABV

A global hop experience featuring cameos from British, American, New Zealand, and Australian varieties that come together with a deep red colour. The mixture of hops allows this little number to be initially sweet but end in a dry earthy finish.

BRIDGEPORT 5.5% ABV

An award-winning IPA has a floral, citrusy aroma and full hop flavour with a subtle bitterness.

It's brewed with a blend of five hop varieties and the effervescence is the result of natural-conditioning—a traditional brewing process, meaning it is not force carbonated, but instead ages slowly and naturally into the beer. This creates a smooth, multilayered and assertive ale, admired for its fragrant citrus and floral aromas,



RIVERSIDE "SEVENTY SEVEN" IPA 7.7% ABV

Seventy Seven is a big American style IPA and a celebration of hops utilising four different hops throughout the brewing process. Seventy Seven starts big then finishes clean leaving you wanting more. But be careful, as this one's a real heavyweight!

Seventy Seven IPA is unfiltered and bottle conditioned for maximum taste and enjoyment.



Lagers.

MONTEITH'S GOLDEN LAGER 5% ABV

This naturally malted Golden Lager has a fresh natural yeastiness in the aroma and a smooth malty character. There are just enough hops for a crispness that makes it a really refreshing beer. Enjoy the smooth rounded cashew nut flavour that is coaxed from premium Munich malts.



GROLSCH 6% ABV

Distinctive and perfectly balanced with a clean, biscuity malt character. Grolsch utilises just two hops to create its balanced taste: a taste hop and an aromatic hop. Grolsch uses just four ingredients: hops, barley, yeast and water.

VALE LAGER 4.5% ABV

Approachable, sessionable, balanced and flavoursome. This beer is filtered for smooth and refreshing crispness with medium carbonation. The 100% malted grain profile is a combination of Pilsner, Carapils and Light Munich, whilst the hop bill includes the noble German hop Tettnang, Australian Helga and NZ Pacifica. The sweet malt characters are balanced by the earthy spice and fresh citrus kick and floral notes derived from the hops.



CARLTON DRAUGHT 4.6% ABV

Being a traditional, full-strength lager, Carlton Draught is crisp on the mid-palate with a good malt character and smooth full-bodied flavour. Clean hop bitterness gives the brew a slightly dry finish. Synonymous with the origins of the Carlton Brewery itself, Carlton Draught is renowned for tasting as fresh as it did the day it was brewed. It's that kind of consistency in taste that's been important to Australians for generations.

HEINEKEN 5% ABV

The ever-popular flagship brew of Dutch brewing giant Heineken International, founded in 1864 by Gerard Adriaan Heineken in Amsterdam. Crisp, clean and refreshing, this ever-popular beer is a classic European style Lager.



PERONI 5.1% ABV

Peroni Nastro Azzuro is brewed to the authentic Italian recipe originating in Lombardia, Italy in the 19th century. Brewed under licence to produce a fresh and crisp taste, Peroni Nastro Azzurro can now be found in all good cafés and bars and is the perfect lager to quench a serious thirst.



BECKS 5% ABV

Beck's was founded in 1873 and has been dedicated to quality and innovation since its inception. Still brewed today under the German Purity Law of 1516, Beck's offers a distinctly crisp and flavoursome lager direct from Germany.



Tiger

A lot goes into making Tiger beer. Using only the finest ingredients from around the world, every drop of Tiger goes through a strict brewing process. A process that includes taste testing over 10 different water samples a day for the freshest water available, and more than 200 quality checks.

These make up part of a brewing process which takes over 500 hours. It's little wonder that Tiger has won over 40 international awards and accolades. And counting.

Brewed with passion in Asia since 1932, Tiger beer is backed by a tradition of excellence. Indeed, it is a story of one beer's quest to become the very best in the world. Which is little wonder Tiger's award-winning taste has picked up over 40 international accolades and awards to date, including a Gold Medal at the 2004 World Beer Cup, organised by The Association of Brewers.

ASAHI 5% ABV

Asahi beer is brewed from quality ingredients. By using pure cultured yeast and advanced brewing techniques Asahi beer has excellent richness, truly refreshing drinkability and satin smoothness.



YOUNG HENRY'S NATURAL LAGER 4.2% ABV

An unfiltered lager made with three types of Australia hops. A crisp and refreshing beer made for afternoon drinking in the sun.



TIGER BEER 5 % ABV

The fresh flavour and mild aftertaste of Tiger Beer makes it the perfect remedy to hot and humid weather as of that in its homeland, South East Asia. When served chilled, the silky texture of Tiger turns crisp, providing a refreshing contrast to the spicier dishes of Thailand and Malaysia, while the malt and honey tones in the body of the beer are light enough to compliment even the most delicate Asian flavours.



THE ROSE (LOW CARB) 4.6% ABV

Brewed by our friends at Monteith's Brewery, this is a refreshingly lively lager naturally brewed 33% longer to remove all the sugars you don't need and give you all the flavour you want. With hints of tropical fruit and a mild bitterness it also has a surprising long finish. Special Jug prices available all year round.




STELLA 5.2% ABV

The unique Stella Artois yeast strain (the very same yeast strain first used by the Artois brewmasters) adds a light to moderate fruity, cooked pineapple aroma and creates a clean, crisp medium bodied flavour with hints of cooked vegetable. The Saaz hop also produces a unique bitterness which is well balanced with the malted barley, giving Stella Artois a subtle but pleasant grainy, sweet finish.

HOFBRAU ORIGINAL 4.9% ABV

This beer has a golden colour with a white foamy head. Made famous by its engrained association with Oktoberfest, this lager has a flowery fragrance and a well-balanced hoppy flavour on the back of the beer. The brewery was formed in 1589 and was originally built right in the centre of the city. Quintessentially German.





SPATEN 5.2% ABV

Upfront there is a moderate flavour of biscuit malts with a lighter amount of cereal grain malts contributing just a touch of sweetness. That is followed by light to moderate flavours of grassy and spicy hops which contribute a light to moderate amount of bitterness which lingers for a short amount of time.



STIEGL GOLDBRÄU 4.9% ABV

Stiegl Goldbräu boasts an unrivalled, well rounded, balanced and wonderfully thirst-quenching flavour. Mildly hopped with a typical refreshing beer bouquet, golden colour, a magnificent fine head and pleasant aftertaste, Stiegl Goldbräu is the enjoyment of beer at the highest level.

Pilsners.

WICKED ELF PILSNER 5% ABV

The Little Brewing Company's version of the original golden coloured lager (Bohemian Pilsner). A pale golden Pilsner with a creamy white head and a spicy,floral hop aroma from the imported Czech Saaz hops. The aftertaste is a balance of malt and hops with a medium body and a lingering bitter finish. This Pilsner should be treated like a white wine and matched with white meats, but is also excellent with seafood, especially natural oysters.



RESCH'S DRAUGHT 4.4% ABV

Originally brewed by Resch's brewery until 1929, Resch's is only available in NSW. A classic for those in the know, and vintage for hipsters and those under 70. Feel free to ask our local Resch's connoisseur, Lindsay, what he thinks of it. Dare you to ask his age!!!

NEVER FORSAKE FLAVOUR

The James Squire trademark dates back to 1806, when First Fleet convict James Squire built his Brewery, The Malting Shovel Tavern, on the shores of the Parramatta River. Today, more than 150 years later, his legacy is brought to life by creating exceptional, flavoursome and truly unique beers in his name.



JAMES SQUIRE'S "FOUR WIVES" PILSENER 5% ABV

James Squire Pilsener is brewed using Pale and Munich malts, Saaz hops and lager yeast.

With a cool fermentation and extended maturation, the result is an authentic brew of sparkling golden brilliance, distinctive floral hop aroma and enticing spicy finish.

**GRIFTER "THE TORTOISE & THE HOP"
PILSNER 6.2% ABV**

An all New Zealand hopped Pilsner bursting with pungent aromatics thanks to the use of Motueka & Nelson Sauvín. The heavy use of these hops give big grape like aromas akin to a Sauvignon Blanc. The slow and cooler fermentation required for this style gives the beer a clean and crisp finish, making way for a pleasant lingering bitterness. Completely unfiltered - this is our big bodied, massively hopped version of a timeless, classic style.



**LITTLE CREATURES ORIGINAL PILSNER
4.6% ABV**

With Tasmanian Helga, New Zealand Pacifica and Saaz hops added throughout the brewing process this beer has a light, fresh flavour and a crisp bitterness. Extended fermentation makes this a clean beer, perfect for whetting ones whistle on a hot day.

TRUMER PILS 4.9% ABV

An excellent example of a traditional European craft Pilsner of the highest quality. It is brewed by Trumer Brauerei in Salzburg, Austria, a 400-year old brewery located in the scenic alpine country. Trumer Pils is the world's first international craft Pilsner, as it is now brewed in two dedicated sister breweries on two sides of the globe; the original brewery in Austria, and at the second, newest Trumer Brauerei in Berkeley, California.



MOO BREW PILS 5% ABV

A Pilsner-style with a crisp, noble hop aroma, balanced by a light biscuit and toast malt profile.

It redefines the classic lager, challenging the cherished belief that Pilsners can only be made in Pilsen.



Dark beers.

MONTEITH'S BLACK ALE 5% ABV

This Black Ale is crafted from a blend of five premium malts to create a complex depth of flavours with dominant coffee notes. Crisper than sweet darks and smoother than harsh stouts, this Black Ale is an ideal companion in cold weather.



MONTEITH'S DOPPELBOCK WINTER ALE 6% ABV

A smooth, rich beer with a powerful aroma and fiery red hue that comes from the crafting of four premium malts in a truly Bavarian style.



WHITE RABBIT DARK ALE 5% ABV

A refreshing Dark Ale, full of imagination with a hint of wonder. Gentle malt driven toffee and caramel flavours blend with subtle fruit aromas derived from an open fermentation, and are all bound together by a reassuring bitterness.

VALE ALE DARK 4.5% ABV

Brewed using pale, Munich, Crystal and Carafo roasted malts the Vale Dark Ale is a filtered beer with brilliant clarity. It is dark brown in colour with ruby and garnet highlights. It has a strong malt backbone with hints of coffee, chocolate and cocoa.



CAVALIER BROWN 5% ABV

This Dark Ale is full of rich, complex malt flavours. Using a broad mix of chocolate and Crystal malts, this ale delivers an initial burst of caramel sweetness soon followed by a dry, crisp roasted note.



WICKED ELF PORTER 5.4% ABV

Craft brewed using the finest Australian, German and British malted barley and classic English hops to balance. Overall rich, full-bodied, seductively smooth and sessionable, yet complex and rewarding. It is a perfect winter beer, yet can be enjoyed year round.

BADLANDS DARK LONDON PORTER
4.8% ABV

A robust English Porter. Dark and delicious with a mild smoky aroma. Chocolate, rum and orange flavours all come from the five malts used.



4 PINES STOUT 5.1% ABV

A dry Irish style stout, presenting almost black, bearing a generous tan head. The aroma profile is of coffee, chocolate and caramel malts. These are matched on the pallet with a full bodied, smooth finish and a balancing bitterness. Currently being tested to become the first certified ‘space beer’ in the world!



The Lord Nelson Brewery Hotel is Sydney's oldest, continually licensed hotel and microbrewery. They

hand-craft their beers, which are brewed using 100% natural ingredients with no added sugars or preservatives. Today there are six Mainstay Ales,

with names inspired by the pub's history and its association with the Lord Nelson himself; Quayle

Ale, Trafalgar Pale Ale, Three Sheets, Victory Bitter, Old Admiral and Nelson's Blood. As well as a steady round of seasonal ales: 111, Broadside, Anileation, Royal Red, One Eye Rye and Double Nelson.

“NELSON’S BLOOD” PORTER 4.9% ABV

Roasted specialty malts combine to create a rich and creamy ale with choc-mocha characters and a smooth roasted finish.



**LORD NELSON “OLD ADMIRAL” ENGLISH
DARK ALE 6.1% ABV**

Strong full bodied malt driven ale that has hints of caramel, balanced with generous hop bitterness, flavour and warmth. Red with black highlights.

MAD ABBOTT DUBBEL 6.9% ABV

Malty with complex fruity esters, raisins, plums, spice, chocolate and a distinct rum character. This rich and malty Dubbel is made in the Belgian Trappist style and is bottle conditioned and cellared before release.



**GRIFTER "THE OMEN" OATMEAL STOUT
4% ABV**

The Omen is an American style oatmeal stout and is all about rich malt character. The complexity which comes from the use of six different varieties is layered to give notes of chocolate, coffee and general roasted goodness. Along with these highly kilned specialty malts is a healthy addition of oatmeal. This common house hold cereal is used to give a full bodied experience along with a velvet like texture which works in harmony with a beer of this style.

**RIVERSIDE “EIGHTY EIGHT” ROBUST
PORTER 6% ABV**

This dark, mahogany coloured ale was a favourite with the workers in 19th century London. This Porter is well balanced between malt and hops with subtle notes of chocolate and coffee resulting in a smooth and very drinkable dark beer.



MOO BREW DARK ALE 5% ABV

This American Brown ale uses resinous hop flavour in synergy with caramel, chocolate and a lightly roasted finish. Gentle hops with a piney aroma blend for a well balanced whole.



**LITTLE CREATURES “MR OBADIAH”
6.9% ABV**

Inspired by a traditional English porter, Mr O is brewed with malted rye that smacks of pepper and spice. With rich dark chocolate, dark caramel and coffee flavours, this is an ideal beer to stock up on for those winter months.

Wheat Beer.

FRANZISKANER HEFE WEISSBIER 5% ABV

In 1363 the Franziskaner Brewery was instituted in the outskirts on Munich. The name comes from the order of the Franciscan monks who used to brew and consume this beer as a source of nutrition during times of fasting. The beer has a creamy, dense foam and a copper colour. The aroma and palate is one that marries banana, vanilla and clove. It has a zesty texture character with a tart finish. Great with lighter foods such as seafood, white meats and salads



MONTEITH'S UNFILTERED APRICOT WHEAT BEER 5% ABV

This Apricot Wheat Beer is based on a traditional Bavarian Heffeweizen with added sweetness. Sun-ripened Otago apricots balance the tart, clove and banana flavours of the wheat malt and special yeasts. This is then overlaid with a fine, noble hop to create a fresh, spicy finish.

HOEGAARDEN 5% ABV

Hoegaarden White is subtly flavoured with Coriander and Curaçao, pouring in a swirling cloud of yeast with a pale yellow, almost putty colour and strong white head. It is intensely aromatic, with lots of lemony fruit, spices and a hint of white chocolate. There is plenty of yeasty aroma, that's quite high and floral. On the palate it is very easy-drinking with plenty of spicebox nuances, a vaguely medicinal hint and a crisp, fruity, refreshing style.



WICKED ELF WITBIER 5% ABV

A light ale, with a lovely complexity of malt, citrus and spicy flavours, balanced with a refreshing bitterness from the hops and curacao. With a dry, slightly bitter finish, this witbier is matched well with seafoods and Thai.



THE LITTLE BREWING COMPANY

The Little Brewing Company, Port Macquarie, is a multi medal winning craft brewery owned and operated by the people who brew the beer.

Launched in June 2007, the brewery fast built its reputation by consistently producing high quality beer with a no compromise attitude. The beer is made from the freshest, finest, all natural ingredients available – malted grain, hops, yeast, speciality spices and the excellent local water. No preservatives or additives are used and the beer is not pasteurised so it retains the full flavour and aroma the brewer meant it to have.

Proud of its regional NSW heritage, this little brewery is a world class producer, and one of the leading craft breweries in Australia, having received more than 60 medals in national and international competitions in its short history.

4 PINES HEFEWEIZEN 5.2% ABV

A German born wheat beer. Cloudy and pale straw in appearance, mild sweet nose with hints of banana exhibiting a well rounded palate showing characters of banana and spice.



GRIFTER “MR MIDNIGHT” BLACK RYE WITBIER 4.5% ABV

Mr Midnight was brewed exclusively for the Great Australian Beer Spectacular 2013. They took a traditional wheat beer recipe as a base using over 50% wheat malt, dosed it with highly kilned black wheat for colour and a touch of rye for a dry, slightly tart finish. Staying slightly true to style they also included some mild spice additions along the lines of coriander, fennel, cloves and even orange peel. All this combined with a phenolic Belgian yeast blend, there's enough here to keep you busy until well after midnight...



The Grifter Brewing Company began in early 2012 when three home brewers were given the opportunity to take their recipes from the backyard, to a brand new shiny stainless steel brewery in Sydney's Inner-west. Since then the three have been honing their skills and unleashing their hand crafted ales across Sydney & Australia. Quality over quantity is always the motto as they focus on producing unique beers that remain highly drinkable. No corners are cut with the use of high quality ingredients and traditional brewing methods.

Cider.

MAGNERS 4.5% ABV

Magners Original Cider can rightfully claim to be the leader of the pack in the world of cider. The unique, refreshing taste of Ireland's favourite Cider over ice is the perfect refreshment over those long, hot summer days.



BULMERS 4.5% ABV

Bulmers Original Cider is quickly becoming a staple in most good pubs around the country.

Bulmers is an authentic English-style apple Cider with a naturally refreshing taste and crisp character. A premium Cider for all occasions



BATLOW 5% ABV

Batlow's "minimal intervention" approach to their cider-making process ensures there are more than 3½ Batlow Apples in every bottle, resulting in one of the freshest tasting ciders on the market, and unlike many commercial ciders, contains no concentrates or added sugars and is gluten free.

Batlow Premium Cider has a light golden appearance with fine bubbles from natural carbonation. The taste gives a mild, refreshing sweetness with distinctive, crisp apple notes followed by a light grip on the back palate and a very clean medium dry finish, resulting in a well-balance, fresh tasting cider.

OLD MOUT BOYSENCIDER 8% ABV

The ingenious union of refreshing apple cider with succulent boysenberry wine creates a drink that has the best of both worlds. Bright red and translucent in colour with a summery burst of berries and a wee hint of cherry, this cider is refreshing rather than overly sweet - like a zing of berry sorbet.



OLD MOUT CLASSIC APPLE 4.5% ABV

An original recipe dating back to 1947, the Old Mout Classic Apple is a light clear cider with a crisp finish. This is apple pure and simple - an easy drinking cider with a nice balance of sweet and tart.

OLD MOUT CIDER

Old Mout (rhymes with 'fruit') has been around the cider scene for nigh on 60 years and has continued to be a favourite among cider lovers.

Located in Nelson on the south island of New Zealand, this area is prime apple growing territory for Old Mout who use apples that come from less than 50 kilometres away making it a truly local cider. They also avoid sugar, cordials and concentrates so the cider comes out with a natural style taste.

Perfect for the porch on a sunny afternoon.



The Hills Cider Company.

The Hills Cider Company is Australian-made and owned and takes pride in using 100% fresh Australian farmed fruit. Based in the Adelaide Hills of South Australia, the cider is hand crafted in small batches using 100% fruit - never adding concentrate, flavour or water. This produces a crisp, dry, fresh fruit driven style of real ciders.



HILLS APPLE & GINGER 8% ABV 95% Hills Apple 5% Ginger

The ginger is sourced from Buderim in Queensland and is hand pureed. The ginger is then co-fermented with the apple juice. This is a complex blend which balances hints of spice from the Queensland ginger with the fruit driven apple crunch of Adelaide Hills apples. A refreshing medium to dry style cider.

HILLS HONEY MEAD CIDER 6% ABV

This cider uses 100% Adelaide Hills Apple co-fermented with Mallie Bush Honey from McLaren Vale. The sweetness of the honey is balanced out by the acidity of the apples. Like most honey mead, it is a fantastic full bodied style - a great luscious mouthful perfect for winter. As expected, this is a sweeter product because of the honey but the acidity and carbonation helps to balance this out.



OAK CLOUDY APPLE 6% ABV

100% Adelaide Hills Apples, completely un-filtered cloudy cider style. The Oak's Cloudy Apple is barrel-aged, full-bodied and complex. It's a great mouthful due to the extra goodness in the fruit; a very "un-touched" and natural style cider. Nothing else added, just fresh apples and some oak to lush out the palate and build flavour profile. Slightly higher use of Granny Smiths makes this slightly more acidic and drier. This is a more scrumpy style cider.

Scrumpy is cider originally made in the West Country of England. Today the term is used to distinguish locally made ciders produced in smaller quantities and using traditional methods, from mass-produced branded ciders.



MONTEITH'S

Stewart Monteith was a master brewer and troublemaker who was jailed for running an illegal brewery on the West Coast of New Zealand. In 1868 he set about brewing a beer for gold mining men (not the type you want to disappoint). Luckily Stewart didn't disappoint and was defined by the phrase, "It's not all about what you've done; it's what you do next that counts."

After nearly 150 years brewing experience, Monteith's Brewing Company is recognised as one of the leaders in the Australasian craft cider market, with a continuously evolving range in which cider lovers discover something to savour.

The Brewery is located in Greymouth in the remote west coast region of the South Island of New Zealand.

MONTEITH'S CRUSHED PEAR CIDER

5% ABV

This pear cider is made purely with sun-ripened Nelson pears which are first crushed to release their juice, then directly fermented. The end result is a lighter and truer cider.



MONTEITH'S CRUSHED APPLE CIDER

5% ABV

A light refreshing French-style cider made from whole sun-ripened Nelson apples crushed to retain their natural flavour. The result is a lighter cider with full apple flavour and freshness.



The Rose Hotel
